作為本地首間資訊科技專科專上學院,HKIIT亦積極 舉辦及支持各項資訊科技活動,以激發青年對資訊 科技的興趣。其中包括年度遊戲開發界年度盛事 「Global Gam Jam Next Hong Kong」,吸引了超過 40間中學的同學參加。而GDG DevFest亦匯聚逾千名 來自不同行業的科技愛好者,共同分享心得,與志 同道合的科技社群成員交流互動。

Limited, Industrial and Commercial Bank of China (Asia) Limited and IBM. Through these partnerships, HKIIT develops programmes that align with the industry, providing students with a wealth of learning resources and internship opportunities, enabling them to acquire industry knowledge and emerging skills while creating opportunities for professional development.

Diversified emerging technology courses for industry to "SkillsUP"

With technology integrated into different industries, training new talents have become a pressing-need for businesses. To assist companies, industry practitioners and working adults in mastering the latest technologies and digital skills, HKIIT has launched an in-service training service called "SkillsUP" to offer reskilling and upskilling programmes to foster digital transformation for companies across various industries. Currently, the institute has been providing a number of in-service continuing education opportunities for working adults. The covered topics include "Professional Certificate in Information Security" and "Certificate in Prompt Engineering for ChatGPT", etc., which aims to enhance industry competitiveness. HKIIT is also committed to becoming a prominent IT training and examination hub in Hong Kong and the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area to help expand the talent pool in the IT industry.

As the first dedicated IT tertiary institute in Hong Kong, HKIIT actively organises and supports a diverse range of IT-related events to inspire the youths' interest. Among all includes the annual event in the game development industry "Global Game Jam Next Hong Kong", which has attracted participation from over 40 secondary schools. Meanwhile, GDG DevFest also brought together more than a thousand of technology enthusiasts from HKIIT has received enthusiastic responses from various

different industries to share ideas and interact with like-minded individuals in the tech community. Looking ahead, HKIIT will continue to deepen its connections with the industry and expand collaboration network. In addition to launching the series of "Digital Leaders Dialogue" talks in April, HKIIT

will hold a two-day event in June with guests from the Government, industry, schools and the public to witness the official establishment of HKIIT. This event symbolises the institute's collaboration with multiple

stakeholders in nurturing future IT talents.
