VTC welcomes new students and launches new programmes as the new school term commences

迎新活動助新生適應新學年

迎接新學年,VTC各院校於8月底舉辦迎新活動,為新生提供校園資訊,向他們介紹各項學生活動及服務等。除本地生外,VTC這學年亦迎來約700名非本地生入讀高級文憑課程,以及約170名非本地生入讀香港高等教育科技學院(THEi高科院)的學士學位課程;當中,超過八成來港修讀高級文憑課程的學生修讀「職專畢業生留港計劃」(VPAS)合資格的VTC全日制高級文憑課程,畢業後可申請留港從事與課程相關的工作,發展專業。

為協助非本地生適應新學習環境,投入校園生活,院校除在迎新日安排校園參觀、介紹學校資訊和支援服務外,亦安排一連串活動,包括廣東話和英語工作坊、本地遊及社區導覽、適應交流會等,促進學生交流,建立人際網絡,全方位照顧學生身心健康。VTC不僅提供先進的校園及學習設施,亦設有學生舍堂,讓非本地生可使用舍堂住宿服務,體驗豐富多采的舍堂生活。

新課程應對行業發展及人才 需求

配合業界的人才需求,VTC於這學年亦推出多個新課程,涵蓋不同專業領域及資歷,包括運動教練學學士學位課程;寵物護理及保健、遊戲為本學習、電腦及數據工程高級文憑課程;數碼媒體學基礎課程文憑;以及寵物護理及美容,和音樂及媒體製作職專文憑課程,收生情況理想,反映課程配合行業發展趨勢,學生亦對職專教育及相關行業就業前景充滿信心。未來,VTC將繼續積極發展多元課程,為各行各業培育更多專業人才。

The Government attaches great importance to promoting vocational and professional education and training (VPET) and developing Hong Kong into an international education hub, aiming to nurture versatile talents to support industry development. In line with the Government initiatives, VTC is committed to enriching the VPET pathways to provide students with diverse study options.

Welcoming new students with orientation activities

As the new academic year commences, VTC member institutions held orientation activities in late August to welcome new students and provide them with information about campus life and various resources available for students. This year, in addition to local students, the VTC also welcomes about 700 non-local students enrolling in Higher Diploma (HD) programmes, and some 170 non-local students for the bachelor's degree programmes offered by the Technological and Higher Education Institute of Hong Kong (THEi). Among which, over 80% of non-local HD students have chosen the eligible HD programmes under the Vocational Professionals Admission Scheme (VPAS) and would be allowed to stay in Hong Kong and work in professions relevant to their study programmes after graduation.

To help non-local students settle in and get familiarised with the new learning environment, alongside the campus tours and induction talks about support services, other activities such as Cantonese and English workshops, local tours and sharing sessions were also arranged to foster student interactions and expand their social networks. In addition to well-equipped campus and learning facilities, VTC Halls of Residence are also available to provide accommodation for non-local students, enriching their campus life with a fruitful hall experience.

New programmes in response to industry developments and talent needs

In response to the industry manpower demands, VTC has introduced several new programmes in this academic year, covering various professional areas and levels. These include the Bachelor of Social Sciences in Sports Coaching; Higher Diploma programmes in Pet Care & Wellness, Play-based Learning, and Computer & Data Engineering; Diploma in Foundation Studies in Digital Media Studies; as well as Diploma of Vocational Education programmes in Pet Care & Grooming as well as Music & Media Production. All these programmes are well received by students, showing their confidence in the new VPET programmes, the industries and the career prospects. Moving forward, VTC will continue our wide range of programme provision, cultivating talents to support different industries.
